Background

As at the date of this agreement, a building consent has been granted in relation to the household unit but a code compliance certificate has not been issued.

<u>Section 364(1)</u> of the Building Act 2004 (**Act**) provides that a residential property developer commits an offence if that developer completes a sale of the household unit or allows the purchaser into possession of the household unit before a code compliance certificate has been issued for the household unit, unless the parties enter into an agreement in accordance with section 364(2) of the Act.

The parties wish to enter into this agreement under <u>section 364(2)</u> of the Act to enable the residential property developer to complete a sale of the household unit or to allow the purchaser of the household unit to enter into possession of the household unit before a code compliance certificate has been issued in relation to the household unit.

Agreement

- (1) In consideration of entering into the contract, the parties agree that the residential property developer may, before a code compliance certificate has been issued in relation to the household unit,—
 - *(a) complete the sale of the household unit:
 - *(b) allow the purchaser to enter into possession of the household unit.
- (2) If there is any conflict between this agreement and the contract, the provisions of this agreement prevail.
