Go to **www.chbdc.govt.nz**, click on my property and then rates by email. You'll need a past rates invoice handy for your valuation information.

Make the switch!

Keep it easy – make the switch to direct debit!

Switching to direct debit is easy, and it's the simplest way to pay your rates. Once you sign up for direct debit you'll:

- Avoid penalty fees for late or incorrect payments
- Have payments adjusted automatically from year to year
- Choose a payment frequency to suit your budget – weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly or annually.
- · No queuing, cheques or postage
- · Have peace of mind
- If you would like to sign up on direct debit go to www.chbdc.govt.nz to complete an online form.

Flush your pipes before you start!

Some plumbing fittings have the potential to allow minute traces of metal to accumulate in water standing in the fittings for several hours. Although the health risk is small, the Ministry of Health recommends that you flush a cupful of water from your drinking water tap each morning before use to remove any metals that may have dissolved from the plumbing fittings. We are recommending this simple precaution for all households, including those on public and private water supplies.

Rates Relief Available

Rates Rebate: If you are on Super, the pension, on a benefit, or your combined income is within a certain threshold then you may be entitled to a rate rebate.

Rates Relief Policies: Council have adopted new rates relief policies as part of our Economic Recovery Action Plan, to assist eligible residential, rural and commercial property owners in their recovery from COVID-19 and the declared drought.

- **Your Valuation Number** This is required as a reference for payments.
- **Property Values**
 - Land Value: used to calculate the District Land Transport rate
 - · Capital Value: used to calculate the general rate and stormwater operations rate
- Your legal description of your property
- **Description of Rates** (2020/2021 rate)
 - General Rate (0.10890 cents per dollar) Based on rateable capital value of all rateable land within the district. Pays for all or some of the cost for:
 - Community leadership, including administration, cost of democracy, community voluntary support grants
 - All regulatory activities, including district planning, land use and subdivision consent costs, building control, public health, animal control & compliance
 - Solid Waste, Parks & Reserves, public toilets, theatres & halls, cemeteries and miscellaneous property costs
 - District Land Transport Rate (0.21871 cents per dollar) Based on the land value of all rateable land in the district. This funds the operation and maintenance of the land transport system (roading network).
 - Refuse Collection (\$30.18) Pays for the collection of household and commercial rubbish (refuse) for houses in the collection area.
 - Sewerage Operations Rate (\$826.70 connected to the public sewerage system, \$413.35 not connected but within 30m of such a drain).

- · This funds the maintenance, operation and capital upgrades of the sewerage collection, treatment and disposal systems in those parts of the District where these systems are provided.
- Stormwater Operations (0.09105 cents per dollar) This funds the operations and maintenance, plus improvements on the stormwater drainage network for Waipukurau and Waipawa Stormwater Catchment Areas.
- Water Supply Operations (\$789.33 connected, \$394.66 serviceable, not connected) This funds water supplies for Otane, Takapau, Waipukurau, Waipawa, Kairakau, Porangahau and Te Paerahi. This rate also includes the maintenance, operation and capital upgrades of water supplies and treatment.
- Recycling Collection (\$99.84) Pays for Waipukurau & Waipawa kerbside recycling
- District UAGC (Uniform Annual General Charge) (\$290.53) This pays for economic and social development, a portion of the cost of solid waste, libraries and swimming facilities.
- Your total annual rates for the financial year
- Opening balance as at 1 July 2020 If there is a balance showing this may indicate an amount owing or a credit balance from the previous year. Contact the Rates team to discuss.
- Less rebates & remissions If you applied for a rates rebate this will show here or if penalties have been reversed.
- Total now due 20 August 2020 This is what you owe for this quarter.
