(Pursuant to the Tenth Schedule, of the Local Government Act 1974)

Closure of roads to ordinary vehicular traffic

UNDER the provisions of the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974, Section 342 (b), notice is hereby given that the Council will temporarily close the following roads to ordinary vehicular traffic for the hours specified, for the purpose of the Targa New Zealand 2020 Rally Event.

Date of Closure: Saturday 4th & Sunday 5th July 2020

Roads proposed to be closed to ordinary vehicular traffic:

Stage 4: RAUKAWA 11.55am to 4.25pm (Saturday)

Start: Hastings District, Entering into CHB via Argyll Rd. past The Brow Rd. Range Rd. College Rd. Hickey Rd. end Arayll Rd 200m from its intersection with SH2.

Stage 5: MOTERE/FARM/MIDDLETON 1.25pm TO 5.55pm (Saturday)

Start Motere Rd, 200m from its intersection with Long Range Rd.

Right into Farm Rd, past Pattison Rd, Te Awa Rd, Carlyon Rd, Stanton Rd, left into Middleton Rd, end 200m from its intersection with Porangahau Rd.

Stage 7: ELSTHORPE 7:35am to 12:05pm (Sunday)

*Change to end location

Start: Hastings District, entering CHB via Kahuranaki Road, right into Elsthorpe Rd, past Kenderdine Rd, Atua Rd, St Lawrence Rd, end approx. 2km east of Patangata Bridge.

Stage 8: PORANGAHAU 9:45am to 2:15pm (Sunday)

Start Porangahau Rd. 300m from its intersection with Old Hill Rd. past Wilder Rd, Mangaorapa Rd, Wimbledon Rd, Birch Rd, straight onto Route 52, end Tararua District.

Stage 9: MATAMAU ORMONDVILLE/TOURERE/NGAHAPE 12:30pm to 5:00pm (Sunday) *Change to end location

Starting in Tararua District, entering CHB on Tourere Rd and end 500m prior to the slip on southern end of Tourere Road.

Stage 10: TOD/MIDDLE ROAD 2:00pm to 6:30pm (Sunday)

Start Tod Road, 200m from its intersection with Pourerere Road, past Evan Rd, right into Elsthorpe Rd, end prior to Patangata Bridge.

Note: To assist with the stage security, the closures also include 50 metres of each adjoining road, from where it intersects with the road.
