### Metered Water Rates and Due Dates

Pursuant to Section 24 of the Local Government (Rating) Act 2002 the following dates are proposed to apply for assessing the amount of metered water rates for the year 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018. The assessment is applied to water users after the first 300 cubic metres of water without additional charge has been used as part of the Water Supply Rate. The Metered Water Rate is \$2.39 per cubic metre (including GST).
