



## Next steps in the Three Year Plan process



Thank you to everyone who provided feedback and submitted on our draft Three Year Plan, which we consulted on from 10 April to 12 May.

The draft plan outlines budget options and trade-offs Council has put forward as councils nationally battle soaring costs such as insurance, interest rates, inflation and historic underinvestment. Central Hawke's Bay is also faced with extra funding challenges and uncertainty following Cyclone Gabrielle.

After reading the 281 submissions received, the Mayor and Councillors heard from individuals and organisations who wanted to speak to their submissions at the oral hearings on Wednesday 22 May. ### What next?

After considering all submissions, the Mayor and councillors will meet to deliberate at a public Council meeting on 30 May and provide final direction to Council officers.

They are scheduled to adopt the final plan on Thursday 13 June 2024, which will set the confirmed budget including rates for the upcoming financial year.

The plan, once confirmed, will come into effect on 1 July 2024.

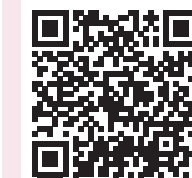
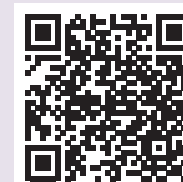
### Nominations are now open!
