Pourerere Beach Reserve gets a makeover



Same glorious view but now with a new visitor experience.

Work to upgrade the reserve at Pourerere Beach is complete and the reserve is now OPEN for all beach-goers to enjoy.

Thanks to funding from the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment as part of the Tourism Infrastructure Fund, Council has developed the 0.5 hectare reserve to better accommodate day visitors and make the beach more accessible for all wishing to enjoy the natural environment and views.



The upgraded, fully accessible beach experience includes a new designated visitor car park; accessible waterless toilet (installed in 2023), walkway and picnic tables; and a bird-watching platform. The reserve upgrade delivers on the actions identified for

this area in Council's Reserve Management Plan, which was developed in consultation with the wider community.

Council thanks the CHB team at Higgins for their amazing, timely work on this project, and for donating the picnic area platforms.

So, grab a picnic and get down to Pourerere Beach to check it out for yourself.
