Otane Alternate Water Supply Celebrating Project Completion

Central Hawke's Bay District Council is pleased to invite the community to celebrate the completion of this flagship project that forms part of #thebigwaterstory!

The community will have the opportunity to hear about the project, how it was delivered, the benefits it will provide to Otane, and have the opportunity to ask council and our engineers any questions.

The Project

5200m of 180mm PE pipe was installed from the SH2 in Waipawa into Otane via Racecourse and White Road.

The new pipeline crosses underneath the railway on Racecourse Road, and was predominantly installed by directional drilling.

This project will now provide significant resilience and security of water supply added to the Otane network.

Key Achievements

- 5200mtrs of 180mm PE pipe
- 9 air valves
- 10 scour/flushing valves
- 9 isolation valves
- 1 pressure reducing valve
