## Current Overview

The Porangahau wastewater treatment plant consists of an oxidation pond to treat the wastewater, prior to discharging into a drain and then into the Porangahau River.



The Te Paerahi Wastewater treatment plant consists of an oxidation pond to treat the wastewater, prior to discharging through a wetland – discharging onto sand dunes.
