Overview

The Takapau Wastewater Treatment plant is situated on Burnside Road, and has a resource consent expiring in October 2021.

Present disposal arrangement is for the wastewater from the oxidation pond to go into a wetland adjacent to the Makaretu River, and then seep into the river through the river gravels.

The consent was extended in 2018 to investigate land discharge options, this is well underway and following a check in with the community in late 2019, we are now ready to present the potential option to progress to a consent.
