Safety improvements to Waipawa's High Street is progressing well with the first stage to upgrade the stormwater network near the Cenotaph completed last week. Stage two kicked off on Monday. Contractors are working hard to complete construction of the two raised platforms by 7 October. During this second stage, a northbound traffic detour is in place 24/7, with parking outside the main street shops available from the south.
