Planned water shutdown and road works



Upgrades underway for parts of Waipukurau.

To complete the water main upgrade on Pōrangahau Road and increase drinking water supply resilience and reliability, we need to shut down the water mains in parts of Waipukurau. The water shutdown will take place on Monday 9 October and Tuesday 10 October from 9pm to 5am. Impacted residents will have received a letter in their mailbox and updates are available on the Council website. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and restore the service as soon as possible.

There will also be road works around the Pōrangahau Road and Gaisford Terrace intersection from Tuesday 10 October to Friday 13 October, during daylight hours, with traffic management in place. Final work to permanently seal Pōrangahau Rd, between Gaisford Terrace and Lake View Road, will run from mid-October to mid-November. Residents in the area will be updated prior to this work taking place.
