



## Rates Rebates Clinic



Rates rebates for 2024/25 of up to \$790 are available. If you are receiving NZ Superannuation, WINZ benefits, or you are a low income household, then you may be eligible to a rates rebate. You must be living at the property and be the legal ratepayer on 1 July 2024.

We are running a series of Rate Rebate Clinics to help you work out if you can apply for a rebate.

At the rate rebate clinics our rates officers are there to:

- help you fill in the form correctly
- answer any questions about the form, eligibility for a rate rebate, or the process to apply
- explain what happens when you get a rate rebate, how it affects your rates in general, and how it affects any direct debit set up.
