Management approach

- Ensure adequate signage regarding location of public toilets from key recreational areas (eg along Pōrangahau River) with Hawke's Bay Regional Council, working alongside hapū in their development
- Work with Hawke's Bay Regional Council to further clarify coastal dune management responsibilities and boundaries including walkway management, invasive weeds and proactive planting and fencing and opportunities for local hapū engagement and involvement
- Through the camping bylaw, seek to further manage and control freedom camping in the freedom camping area including appropriate management support
- Continue to work with community groups in the wider management and improvement of the reserve areas
- Plan to upgrade the toilets and day parking area at main carpark
- Continue to protect and maintain conservation values and natural character of the reserve
- Ensure provision for day trippers so that local whānau and friends can visit on day trips
- Develop vegetation management plan and seek funding through the 2024-34 Long Term Plan
